INFORMATION SHEET 2010 PCYC's in SYDNEY

The **Arrive alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** is designed to remind young people that getting behind the wheel is a big responsibility – their lives and those of others is quite literally in their hands. The message “Arrive alive” raises consciousness of the value of life and the importance of road safety awareness. Furthermore, this program raises awareness of wheelchair sport and creates a greater understanding of people with disabilities.

Fully trained and experienced Wheelchair Sports NSW (WS NSW) presenters and athletes will hold a road safety talk at your PCYC for local youths on driving behaviours and the way to increase their own road safety decision making. The presentation also covers the consequences of poor choices with risk taking behaviours, highlighting that it can happen to anyone.

This point is further reinforced with a game of wheelchair basketball, where the students/youths are invited to participate. It enables the students to experience what it's like to be in a wheelchair, if only temporarily, as they are able to walk away after the game. All of this makes the **Arrive alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** an innovative and unique program designed for secondary school aged students across NSW.

- **WHERE:** Your PCYC basketball court
- **WHEN:** Monday to Friday from 9am to 5pm (note: subject to availability).
- **HOW:** Our presenters/athletes will visit your venue, providing road safety information, personal stories of road accidents, discussion and question time, 12 basketball wheelchairs, hoops and balls (if required).
- **NO. OF SESSIONS:** A minimum booking of 2 hours is required each day. This can be broken up into 2 x 1 hour sessions with up to 30 youths in each session.
- **SESSION SIZE:** 30 participants per session – recommended maximum number. Staff supervision is compulsory at all times during the Roadshow
- **COST:** **\$300 for 2 sessions @ 1 hour long**
\$350 for 3 sessions @ 1 hour long

All prices include GST
