INFORMATION SHEET 2010 REGIONAL – OVERNIGHT STAY

The **Arrive Alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** is designed to remind young people that getting behind the wheel is a big responsibility – their lives and those of others is quite literally in their hands. The message “Arrive Alive” raises consciousness of the value of life and the importance of road safety awareness. Furthermore, this program raises awareness of wheelchair sport and creates a greater understanding of people with disabilities.

Fully trained and experienced Wheelchair Sports NSW (WS NSW) presenters go directly into schools and community groups and talk with youth about driving behaviours and the way to increase their own road safety decision making. The presentation increases spinal injury awareness and shows the consequences of poor choices with risk taking behaviours, highlighting that it can happen to anyone.

This point is further reinforced with a game of wheelchair basketball, where the students are invited to participate. It enables the students to experience what it’s like to be in a wheelchair, if only temporarily, as they are able to walk away after the game. All of this makes the **Arrive alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** an innovative and unique program designed for secondary school students across NSW.

Regional schools: The Roadshow program would like to visit schools in regional NSW at least 8 to 10 times per year. It is preferable that each regional trip is 1 week in duration from Monday to Friday, so if your school is interested in booking a roadshow presentation, please complete the booking form with your preferred dates and we will try to arrange other schools in your area for the same week. If you have contact with local schools and can help with organizing other bookings, it would be appreciated.

Costs: Due to the extra costs incurred with visiting regional NSW such as overnight accommodation, we require a full day’s booking each day. The cost for a regional roadshow is either **\$400 for 4 x 1 hour sessions or \$450** for 5 or more sessions. If your school is small and you wish to share the sessions with another local school the cost for **2 x 1 hour sessions is \$300** but you must organize another school to book the other 2 x 1 hour sessions.

Facilities: To hold a roadshow presentation we require a wheelchair accessible area such as a gymnasium, hall or outdoor basketball courts. Our presenters need a fairly quiet area to do the 20 minute road safety talk (unless we do this talk at an assembly) and we require a flat surface suitable to play wheelchair basketball. If you do not have basketball hoops and balls we can bring them with us. The presenters will also require the use of wheelchair accessible toilets throughout the day.
