III. YOUR FACILITIES

To successfully hold the Roadshow including a game of wheelchair basketball we require a flat, even surface such as a basketball court, tennis court or hall to play wheelchair basketball. We can bring portable basketball hoops, but for safety of the participants they do need to play on a flat surface. Our presenters are in wheelchairs so they require access to disabled toilets and suitable access to the area where the roadshow will take place. We also advise that the area should be fairly quiet and without distractions from other students.

The **Arrive Alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** is designed to remind young people that getting behind the wheel is a big responsibility – their lives and those of others is quite literally in their hands. The message “Arrive Alive” raises consciousness of the value of life and the importance of road safety awareness. Furthermore, this program raises awareness of wheelchair sport and creates a greater understanding of people with disabilities.

Fully trained and experienced Wheelchair Sports NSW (WS NSW) presenters go directly into schools and community groups and talk with youth about driving behaviours and the way to increase their own road safety decision making. The presentation increases spinal injury awareness and shows the consequences of poor choices with risk taking behaviours, highlighting that it can happen to anyone.

This point is further reinforced with a game of wheelchair basketball, where the students are invited to participate. It enables the students to experience what it’s like to be in a wheelchair, if only temporarily, as they are able to walk away after the game. All of this makes the **Arrive alive Wheelchair Sports Roadshow** an innovative and unique program designed for secondary school students across NSW.

- **WHERE:** Your School/ Organisation (Multi purpose unit, Basketball/Tennis Court, Quadrangle)
- **WHEN:** Monday to Friday from 9am to 5pm (note: subject to availability).
- **HOW:** Our presenters/athletes will visit your venue, providing information, discussion, 12 basketball wheelchairs, hoops and balls (if required).
- **NO. OF SESSIONS:** 2 x 1 hour sessions (minimum)
3 x 1 hour sessions
4 x 1 hour sessions
Whole day of sessions
- **SESSION SIZE:** 30 participants per session – recommended maximum number.
Teacher supervision is compulsory at all times during the Roadshow
- **COST:** **\$300 for 2 sessions @ 1 hour long**
\$350 for 3 sessions @ 1 hour long
\$400 for 4 sessions @ 1 hour long
\$450 for whole day (5 + sessions)
